C7.BrindaGaanam Competition THREE: Any other 2 Uthishta Bharata/Jaago Bharat songs

In this (Group/Chorus) singing competition, a competing group should consist of minimum 4 people.

N.B.(1) C1 is based on the quotations from the book "Vivekananda His Call to the Nation". The quiz group has to tell the missing key words in the quotation displayed/quoted in the quiz time.

(2) For the 3 **Cursive Writing & Translation Competitions**, 16 books (8 per gender) of Chicago lectures in English and one book in Telugu are distributed per course. But the Telugu translations written should be students' own. Submissions based on simple copying from the Telugu book will be ineligible for evaluation. One group member has to write in English. Another group member has to write in Telugu. The 3rd and 4th group members are considered to share the group effort. Each submission document should be limited to one paper only- On one side of the paper, English lecture of Swamiji and, on the other side, its Telugu translation should be written. On the top side of the English lecture page, group members' names, roll nos., email-ids and course name should be written for identity.

(3.) For the 3 **BrindaGaanam Competitions**, (i)the books containing the lyrics of the songs are distributed to the students free of cost. The audio songs are available for download for storage into Cell Phone/USB drive for practice/rehearsals by the groups. (a.) The Telugu songs (Uthishta Bharata songs) audio files are available in https://sites.google.com/site/vivekjntu/songs_swamivivekananda_india at the bottom of the webpage (b.) The Hindi songs (Jago Bharat songs) audio files are in <https://sites.google.com/site/chandrasekharaiahk/swamivivekanandavandanaandstutisongs/jagobharatsongs>

(4) For each competition type (a)C1 (b)C2/C3/C4 (c)C5/C6/C7, 16 books (8 per gender) per course are distributed. One Telugu lecture book and 2 Hindi songs books are also distributed per course. The distribution is FREE and per course. The students are requested to share with and care for the classmates and not to be too possessive of the books freely distributed to the class as a whole.

Competitions & Dates: C1 will be held at 4.00 P.M. on 17Jan2017. Last date for group submissions for C2, C3 and C4 for evaluation for prizes: 17Jan2017. C5, C6 and C7 will be held at 4.00 P.M. on 18Jan2017.
